Founded in 1985, the University of Castila-La Mancha es spread out over campuses within four provinces of the autonomous region of Castilla-la Mancha (Spain): Albacete, Ciudad Real, Cuenca and Toledo.

In addition, there are two other university centres located in Talavera de la Reina (Toledo) y Almadén (Ciudad Real).

Since its foundation as a public institution for higher education and research, our University now offers 64 Bachelor's degree programs and 53 official Master's degree programs, all of which are in accordance with the standards of the European Higher Education Area. Additionally, UCLM offers a wide selection of postgraduate courses and doctorate programs.

There are currently over 29,000 students enrolled in the University with a staff of close to 2,847 professors and researchers. Moreover, there are nearly 1,147 administrators and service personnel.

Moreover to teaching, research constitutes another fundamental pillar of UCLM, with over 282 groups dedicated to research. UCLM currently collaborates with more than a thousand regional, national, and multinational companies. This joint collaboration is based primarily on the development of research projects that are

of interest for public and private industry. Furthermore, each year these companies offer internships and traineeship programs for students. Currently, there are more than 4,000 internships offered. Internationally, the University maintains an affiliation with numerous academic centers throughout Europe, and also with several higher education institutions worldwide. This provides many opportunities for teaching and studying in a university community abroad.

The geographical location of UCLM has enabled the university to become a pioneer in the incorporation of new technologies. In addition, the UCLM's commitment to excellence can be seen through its outstanding reputation as one of the best universities in Spain. It ranks among the top fifteen Spanish universities in enrolment, R&D+I funding, and human resources and materials, having low dropout rate, and more library space for students.

Toledo

A city with one of the richest history in Spain. Muslims, Jews and Christians lived together in harmony here for centuries, leaving their indelible mark on Toledo's streets, monuments and buildings. Its old town was declared a World Heritage in 1986. This center sits majestically above the Tagus River and now, represents one of the most visited sites in all Spain.

UCLM has firmed up its presence in Toledo at two different campuses: the Faculties settled in the city's historical quarter and in the old Weapons Factory of Toledo and in Talavera de la Reina, world-renowned for its artistic ceramics, dating back to the 16th century, recognised as Intangible Heritage of Humanity by UNESCO in 2019.

Today, Talavera de la Reina is a modern city that has become an important technological centre, being chosen by leading companies in the sector to set up their offices.



Ciudad Real

Founded by King Alfonso X in the 13th century, Ciudad Real has consolidated itself as one of the most important cities in La Mancha, the land of Don Quixote. It is surrounded by beautiful natural landscapes included in the National Parks list.

The Ciudad Real Campus is located in the center of the city and is home to the Rectorate of the University.

About 100 kilometers away from Ciudad Real, in Almadén, stands the Higher Technical School of Industrial Engineering. It is the result of and also the tribute to the city's mining tradition, a mining district which includes the world's largest mercury mine, exploited in a practically continuous way since Romans times. Almadén was declared a World Heritage site in 2012.

Cuenca

A city which touches all your senses. In 1996 Cuenca was declared by UNESCO a World Heritage City, for its wonderful preservation of the original urban setting with its medieval fortress, its rich civil and religious architecture dating from the 12th to the 18th Centuries and for the exceptional way the city is embraced by its beautiful natural surroundings. Cuenca is undoubtedly one of the most beautiful cities in Spain, where history, art, culture, urban and natural landscapes can all be found in one place.





The campus of Cuenca is situated on the outskirts of the city with a complex of buildings which preserves all historical and artistic tradition determined by the location of a large part of its facilities in a World Heritage City mixed with the most advanced technologies.



Albacete

Located in the historic land of La Mancha it is the largest city in the region. The Albacete campus can be described as a vast area covering public places and green areas, closely tied to the city's urban development and its consolidation in trade and industry. At the Albacete campus, all matters referring to university research and technology-transfer projects are coordinated.





The students at UCLM

The underlying aim of UCLM is to provide information and help its students starting from the preenrolment process and throughout their course studies at UCLM. In addition, we continue to provide assistance to the students during their employment searching process once they've graduated, so that they are able to find employment related to their field of study.

In order to achieve this, there are a series of services built into the University's structure through which UCLM develops and coordi-nates its activities and programs. Most notably are the following: Services for Students with Disabilities, the Centre for Information and the Promotion of Employment, the University Counselling Service, the Sports Service...

Amongst the programs in place, the most representative of these are services such as: the information provided to teaching professionals as well as management of the University's teaching Centers; the coordination and management of UCLM admissions examinations; the channeling and processing of grants and scholarships awarded to students and student associations and unions; internship programs; and finally, the management of student placements in other Spanish universities or institutions.

The International Doctorate School of Castilla-La Mancha is in charge of managing, within its scope, the proper teachings and activities of the doctoral programmes, while developing its own strategy linked to the research strategy of our university. Its organized as an Interdisciplinary School and offers eighteen doctoral programs for the completion of a thesis, all in line with the current legislation and positively evaluated by the national educational authorities. These programs cover the five disciplines: Arts and Humanities, Science, Health Sciences, Law and Social Sciences, Engineering and Architecture and seven of these programs are offered in collaboration with other universities in Spain.

On the one hand, it aims to encourage the specialization and internationalization of groups and centers with a proven track record in basic and experimental research, linked with the strategic priorities of the region. On the other hand, it also seeks to promote research in the fields of humanities and social sciences, as these are considered to be the areas of greatest importance regarding the interdisciplinary nature of applied research at our university.

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The Postgraduate Studies Centre is in charge of the organization, promotion, quality, monitoring and execution of the strategy and offer of postgraduate studies at the University of Castilla-La Mancha, guaranteeing the suitability, quality, competitiveness and internationalization of these studies in the academic and professional fields. The PSC assumed as main function to respond to the demand for an updated, specialized and quality lifelong learning, helping to transmit knowledge to society.

Postgraduate studies are becoming increasingly important, offering a high level of specialized training that also responds

quickly to the needs of the labor market and the interest to recycle and complete their training of students and professionals which, as their own courses, are taught by university professors as well as by professionals of renowned prestige.

The objective of professional specialization allows to create more than 100 own titles every year. The specific titles include the different fields of knowledge (Arts and Humanities, Sciences, Health Sciences, Social and Legal Sciences, Engineering and Architecture) and are taught in different campuses (Albacete, Ciudad Real, Cuenca and Toledo).

Language Centre (CEL)

The Language Centre (CEL) of the University of Castillathe Mancha, attached Vice-Rectorate to Internationalization, has commitment а firm to multilingualism, not only in the university community, but also in society in general.

The two main lines of action of the CEL have to do with language training and language accreditation. The CEL has an extensive language courses offering, through its Learn Languages Program, which includes inperson and online courses in English, French, Italian, German, Japanese and Arabic, in addition to teaching Spanish as a foreign language.

On the other hand, the CEL regularly organizes tests, highlighting, in English, the CertAcles seal for levels B1, B2 and C1, awarded by the Association of Language Centres in Higher Education (ACLES), and in French, the DELF-DALF, being the Language Centre of the UCLM the only one recognized at a regional level. Aimed at international university students, the SIELE exam, promoted by the Cervantes Institute among other prestigious institutions, is offered.

The Confucius Institute at Castilla La-Mancha University established in April 2017. According to the tripartite Agreement among Confucius Institute Headquarters (Hanban), University of Castilla-La Mancha and Nanchang University for the Establishment of the Confucius Institute, it is a non-profit public institution, which aims to promote Chinese language and culture in Castilla La- Mancha autonomous region of Spain.

The Confucius Institute University of Castilla-La Mancha adopts flexible teaching patterns and adapts to suit local conditions when teaching Chinese language and promoting culture in primary schools, secondary schools, communities and enterprises.

The functions of CI UCLM include teaching activities, providing with the support and services of teaching resources, training Chinese teachers, recommending Confucius Institute scholarship and organizing Chinese tests such as HSK, HSKK, YCT etc. It has allowed people of the Castilla La- Mancha region to learn about Chinese language and culture. In addition, it has become a platform for cultural exchanges between China and Spain as well as a bridge reinforcing friendship and cooperation between China and Spain.



The UCLM made an important commitment to research by implementing an ambitious through the implementation of an ambitious Research Plan that includes Research Plan that integrates actions in terms of human resources human resources and funding for the activity of the 282 research groups that exist in our research groups that exist in our institution.

The Ministry of Education, Culture and Sport awarded the Campus of International Excellence CYTEMA of the University of Castilla-La Mancha (UCLM) the highest grade, an "A", so that the project of Scientific and Technological Campus of Energy and Environment obtained the definitive qualification of Campus of Regional International Excellence in the European context, CYTEMA was a commitment of the UCLM for teaching, research and knowledge transfer in energy and environment.

These actions have led to the positioning of the UCLM in the different rankings.

UCLM is leader in Spain of university research in the domain of Veterinary and Energy Science & Engineering. According to the ARWU ranking, Veterinary Science at UCLM has reached the 3th position in Spain and the 40th at world level, whereas Energy Science & Engineering is ranked among ethe 200-300 universities in the world.

The 2023 edition of the Academic Ranking of World Universities known as the 'Shanghai Ranking' establishes the University of Castilla-La Mancha (UCLM) in 674th place, in the 601-700 rank of the best universities in the world. It also occupies 20th place, in the rank 14-20, among the 80 or so Spanish universities. Reforms and changes in research policy over the last ten years have allowed for greater collaboration with other research institutes. With these links, research can be carried out both outside the university and within the university itself.

UCLM is placed in an excellent position in the main national and international rankings that include R&D+I indicators. This is due to the support of emergent research groups, the training of our personnel, and the amount of grants given to increase the number of researchers in relevant international institutions. In addition, technical and financial advice is given in order to promote UCLM's participation in European competitions. Finally, another key factor is the sharing of technology development by UCLM with the public and private sector.

Through the Academic-Sports Conciliation Programme, the UCLM is firmly committed to promoting the conciliation between academic training and sports careers, both in the competitions organised by the UCLM, in which it participates at national and international level, and in participation in federated competitions.

Volunteer Programme

The University of Castilla-La Mancha Volunteering Programme aims to increase the awareness, commitment and participation of our university community in volunteering initiatives and programmes, making them aware of and involved in social problems. The basic idea of the project is to generate models of social transformation and a greater relationship with organisations in the region to stimulate the interest of the university community in solidarity initiatives and to achieve greater involvement with society, placing value on its human capital. Volunteering will be promoted in rural areas of Castilla-La Mancha, with the aim of helping to reduce depopulation, promoting the commitment of our students in these areas.

Summer Courses

The UCLM seeks to ensure the learning of the students helping them holding a wide variety of summer courses. Specialists of different disciplines will provide the students with the learning tools for the discussion of different politic, social, cultural or scientific aspects of nowadays. This programmes offer a wide variety of courses which can be taken by the whole community of Castilla La Mancha.

University Debating League

The University of Castilla La Mancha has developed in all their campuses a University Debate League which has been held for 10 editions. The objective of the debates is to foment the dialogue and defense of ideas in public by the students, which could make the student develop social abilities, analysis of the information, oral expression, listening attitude and speed reply by collaborative work.

University Program for Elder Students

This interesting program offers academic training for people over 50 years with higher studies or not and who want to keep learning (professionals in active employment, retired, preretired, housewives, etc.). Through a wide offer of subjects of different disciplines (Literature, Law, History, Health Sciences, Computing, Sociology, Nature and Environment, Economic Sciences, History of Arts, Psychology, Philology, Philosophy and English) and the complementary activities like workshops, colloquiums, conferences or seminars.

Development Cooperation Grants

An annual call for applications is promoted for the awarding of grants for developing cooperation projects, programmes and actions in the field of teaching and training, applied research and technology and knowledge transfer, which contribute to improving the living conditions and training of populations worldwide, as well as that of the most disadvantaged sectors in the Autonomous Community of Castilla-La Mancha. Beneficiaries may be non-governmental organisations, foundations or other similar organisations, provided that they are non-profit-making and recognised as such. The application must be endorsed by a member of the UCLM university community. UCLM university community: teaching and research staff (PDI), administration and services staff (PAS) or students in any of its regulated courses (bachelor's, master's or doctorate).









Heritage

Despite its youth, the University of Castilla-La Mancha enjoys a rich historic-artistic and environmental heritage on its campuses. Our University has campuses in three World Heritage Sites: Almaden, famous for its mining complex, Cuenca, which has a marvelous old quarter and Toledo, one of the most visited cities in Spain.

In Toledo, various academic institution centers are located in architectural gems such as San Pedro Martir convent, Lorenzana Palace or the Sabatini building.

Our unique buildings are a testimony of the Spanish History. All of them have been renovated over the years, but they have always maintained their charm with the purpose of housing the educational and research activity of UCLM.

In Albacete, the most populated campus in Castilla-La Mancha, university students may enjoy spacious green areas and one of the most accessible urban designs in the whole of Spain. Modernity and tradition go hand in hand in this city.

Moreover, the Ciudad Real campus is located in the only prov-ince of Spain which has two national parks, two essential getaways for those who live in this university city which is accessible, modern and has excellent communication.

In addition, there is a large collection of important paintings, sculptures, photographs, drawings and other historical items of interest at UCLM.
